riéntame has worked continuously throughout the past 40 years so that more and more Colombian women may access safe, high-quality sexual and reproductive health services that respond directly to their needs, contexts and circumstances. This report "everything is different from inside" is a way to share with friends and allies the core of our work.

Ten years after the decriminalization of abortion in Colombia, in 2016, Orientame designed and implemented a series of strategies with the aim of allowing more women to learn about their rights and exercise them in a timely manner. We are still working on one of the Foundation's main challenges: That women may overcome barriers to service provision.

During 2016, we reached out to more girls, young women and adults and we broadened our service coverage in Bogota by opening two new sites in the Suba and Kennedy localities, making our services more accessible to users in those areas. We also expanded the

work of our contact center, increasing the number of advisers who provide adequate primary services and respond to the enquiries of users. We established and strengthened relationships with organizations and institutions that allow us to cover different areas of the country and reach young audiences through specific programs and projects. We want to highlight the importance of technological advances and innovation in the infrastructure of each of our clinics and sites.

Next year, we hope to remain a referent in Colombia and Latin America in the field of comprehensive services geared towards unwanted pregnancy; we will keep working towards breaching the societal gaps that threaten the exercise of many women's sexual and reproductive rights.

In Orientame, women may access abortion services in accordance to the three exceptions decriminalized by Colombian legislation.

We provide counseling for women before, during and after the procedure. Our staff is highly qualified and our equipment and infrastructure are optimal for performing this procedure.

With the aim of allowing more women in different regions of Colombia to access high-quality sexual and reproductive health services we raise awareness among the professional community and we train providers of sexual and reproductive health services. Every day there are more and more professionals being coached in providing personalized services while using cutting-edge techniques.


During 2016, the Orientame foundation operated an alliance between the Ministry of Health and Social Protection and the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA). This allowed an abortion service training and implementation process to take place in 15 health providing institutions and state-owned social enterprises throughout the country. Services were effectively implemented in 87% of them.

Sponsorship program

Our Sponsorship Program delivers services to boys, girls and teens, raising awareness in topics like sexuality and reproduction promoting self-care and informed decision-making as well as preventing sexual violence and unwanted pregnancy. As part of the Sponsorship Program, 74 teenage and adult women accessed long term contraceptive services at Orientame.



- Sexual and reproductive health promotion in youth

During 2016 a youth collective was formed within the Sponsorship Program with the participation of 30 teenagers and young adults as well as their families and friends.

In this group, participants could learn more about sexuality and reproduction. Additionally, a training program in communication tools and strategies began with the aim of connecting to other young people and sharing information about sexuality education within a framework of human rights. The youth collective recorded and transmitted radio shows about sexuality on Facebook through the Punto D platform whith 2,700 visualizations.

In addition, youth workshops took place with the theme "preventing violence against women" as well as sharing experiences with other youth groups.

- Support for primary and secondary education

Orientame has provided support for the basic primary and secondary studies of boys and girls by promoting enrollment in formal education. In 2016, a total of 585 boys, girls and teens received subsidies to purchase school supplies and uniforms and pay for their tuition. 98% of these students remained enrolled in the educational system.

- Financing for undergraduate studies

In 2016, we were also able to finance the technical or technological training of young people enlisted in the program who satisfactorily completed their secondary studies and wished to stay in school but were facing financial constraints. These subsidies, meant to ensure teenagers' and young adults' academic stability, included tuition payments, transportation fees, stationery and snacks

In 2016, 7 beneficiaries of this program advanced in their technical and technological training. One young woman graduated as a nursing assistant and the rest are in the process of completing their studies. As part of the Sponsorship Program, 74 teenage and adult women accessed long term contraceptive services at Orientame.



- Healthy Childhood



Through the Punto D initiative for the promotion of sexual and reproductive rights, the foundation continues to work towards the comprehensive prevention of unwanted pregnancy with a special focus on adolescents.

This program takes place in alliance with the Cundinamarca Health Department, through which we are able to reach out to different municipalities in Fómeque, Funza, Girardot, Soacha, Ubaté and Zipaquirá.



This project will be completed in June 2017, having reached 600 adolescents personally and 6.000 through social media.





Access to safe and legal abortion

services for displaced women



Safe Abortion Action Fund (Saaf)

This Project works toward the recognition, exercise and accountability of reproductive autonomy as a woman's right, implementing a training process in sexual and reproductive rights for professionals in public and private institutions who are tasked with delivering services to victims of the armed conflict. Simultaneously, this initiative enables access to sexual and reproductive health services for displaced women who are experiencing unwanted pregnancies.

In 2016, 322 employees of public and private institutions and 45 social agents linked to organizations that work directly with displaced populations received information regarding the C-355 ruling of 2006. There was an emphasis on intersectional interventions and networks for the promotion of women's rights.

In November, a seminar with Universidad Central was organized the conversation titled "Women's bodies in the Colombian armed conflict- debates on sexual and reproductive rights". More than 350 people attended this event, including students, public servants, social agents and civilians.

Community Leaders: Strategies for the promotion of health and human rights in vulnerable contexts



The Community Leaders Project is implemented with the support of the WestWind Foundation. It aims to promote and disseminate reproductive rights information and enable access to health services through incentives awarded to community leaders who are personally trained and overseen by the Foundation. This project targets vulnerable women.

Reproductive health and rights promotion strategies geared towards vulnerable women are evinced in social interventions conducted by community leaders and non-profit organizations. This is demonstrated in the joint effort between the Orientame Foundation and a group of 30 community leaders in Bogota and Pereira.



Less Barriers and More Access to Legal Abortion in Colombia



Foro de Mujeres v Desarrollo (Fokus)

This project aims to enable access to abortion services and long term contraception for socioeconomically, culturally and politically vulnerable women. This includes indigenous women, adolescents and Afro-Colombian women. The goal is to decrease economic, sociocultural, information and access barriers guaranteeing services that are both comprehensive and culturally sensitive.

Thanks to our alliance with FOKUS, we have strengthened our service model through tools that allow us to take a differential approach, recognizing the

specific needs and characteristics of the women who come to our institution. During 2016, in accordance to the project goal, the foundation opened two sites located in Suba and Kennedy which provide abortion services. A monitoring and evaluation tool was developed to assess the cultural awareness of our service delivery model.



Contracts with health insurance companies (EPS)

The Orientame foundation works in alliance with the Health Insurance companies Coomeva, Famisanar, Nueva EPS and SOS to guarantee safe and timely access to legal abortion services as well as post abortion contraception, especially long-term. In 2016, 19% of users who received abortion services were eligible for support from their respective Health Insurance companies.

This is a very important achievement because it allows women to exercise their sexual and reproductive rights and access services within the framework of their mandatory health insurance plan, decreasing administrative and information barriers

Contact Center


For Orientame, the first contact with our users through our phone line or online chat is an opportunity to provide information, clear doubts, dispel fears and manage their expectations of the process. During 2016 we achieved the following advances:

-We pilot-tested the contact center to make it avai-

lable 7/24, which allowed us to apply this model to our toll-free line and online chat starting February 2017.

-Infrastructural improvements led to the setup of 8 call-center operator work stations, allowing more women to contact us via phone and online chat.



~ Campaigns

- 10 years in the Coffee Region

In 2016, Orientame celebrated a decade of work in the Coffee Region. At the same time, the C-355 ruling that decriminalized abortion in three instances also turned 10. We celebrated by delivering 4.000 free condoms among other activities with different organizations.

- Free condoms and pregnancy tests

During 2016, Orientame created the Sintabú brand of condoms and pregnancy tests. These were approved and endorsed by the respective institutions that control the quality of these items in Colombia.





Condom at the Park

In alliance with the District Institute of the Arts (IDARTES), Orientame attended, the city's annual Rock, Hip Hop and Salsa festivals, delivering near to 150,000 preservatives, the largest free condom distribution in the history of Colombia.

Group distribution of Sintabú

During 2016, nearly 25.000 pregnancy tests and more than 114.000 condoms were distributed on streets, universities and places where young people converge.


Sintabú dispensers
